

## F.C. Virginia Camp Registration Forms

### STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTABILITY

I understand that camp may have certain inherent risks, that the camp environment is different from the city, and that situations may arise that will be dealt with differently than in an urban area. I understand that cell phones may not work at camp or within the surrounding mountains and that cell phones and other electronic devices are discouraged while at camp. Camp Overlook has a conventional telephone which may be used in emergencies.

I, the camper will submit a camp health form prior to camp signed by my parent or guardian. I agree to notify the camp secretary if a health problem occurs between the submission of this form and the first day of camp. I agree to participate in camp within the limits noted on the health form. I also agree to act in a responsible way, respecting other people, as well as the camp property and facilities. I understand that I may be terminated from camp if I act in a negative or threatening way toward others, damage or destroy camp property, or if I fail to obey camp rules or act in an "ungodly" manner.

I will comply with the camps "Code of Conduct and Dress" rules which are included with my registration.

### Conduct and Dress

The purpose of this camp is to provide a clean, wholesome and beneficial environment for all campers in which they can associate with the finest young people (Eccl 12:1; I Cor 15:33). All camp activities are designed to maintain a spiritual atmosphere according to the principles found in the Bible (Matt 6:33). Each camper is required to follow the rules and to respect the instructions of the counselors. This is what your parents would want (Eph 6:1-3).

Dress requirements. Campers must wear modest clothing while at camp (I Tim 2:9-10). Shorts must be knee length. No tank tops or exposed midriff's are allowed for boys and girls. No spandex is allowed. Boys must wear shirts in public areas at all times. No tight revealing clothing will be worn.

Your daily camp attire will be suitable for all camp activities, thus eliminating the need for frequent dress changes. Long pants are recommended for forest activities.

Respectable interaction between boys and girls are expected at all times. Boys are not allowed in girls cabins, and girls are not allowed in boys cabins (II Tim 2:22).

Each camper must stay with the assigned group activities unless the directors state otherwise. Wandering off into seclusion is not allowed.

No smoking, drinking, or drugs are allowed. Prescription and over the counter medications will be checked in with the nurse the first day of camp. The use of profanity is not allowed. Stealing, possession of fireworks/explosives, or any form of weapons are not allowed at camp. (I Cor 6:19-20).

I give my permission for any photos taken at camp to be used for the promotion of camp.

**I have read and understand the camps statement of accountability and conduct and dress rules.**

**By signing this agreement I will abide by the camp rules. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from camp. Tuition is non-refundable.**

## What to Bring to Camp

**Must bring:** Bible (complete text) Old and New Testament & Pens/pencils for writing

**Water bottle with your name on it**

**Bed linens:** Twin sheet set, pillow, blanket , or sleeping bag.

**Bath items:** 2-3 sets of towels/wash cloths

**Shower items:** soap/shampoo, shower shoes (flip flops), brush/comb, toothbrush/toothpaste

**Pajamas:** Two sets recommended

**Swim clothes:** Trunks and a t-shirt for boys. Bathing suit/ knee length cover up is optional for girls. Sunscreen

**Clothing:** Personal items
